- Think about what happens when one side lets the other down. (Genesis 3:17)
- Remember missed opportunities. (Numbers 13)
- Plan ways to correct them, if you are able. (Isaiah 55:6,7)



Exercise for Chapter Two, Section Three

- In the source text, the author describes the manner in which he hears the voice of God (See text box below). With this in mind, consider how God might communicate with you.
- My experience is that receiving a message from the Spirit is akin to receiving a data dump, followed by a complete intuitive understanding. One minute you are unaware, the next minute you have this body of information that seems to have come from nowhere. You simply know and your awareness is incredibly increased. Those that use computers have used this method when transferring files from one drive to another via a program like Windows Explorer.
